- 5 On January 10, the Missionary Tigers won against the Texas Longhorns with a total combined score of 200. If Texas scored 90 points, how many points did Missionary scored?
- 6 Kate has 45 shoes. 30 of the shoes were Reebok the rest were Nike. How many Nikes did she have?
