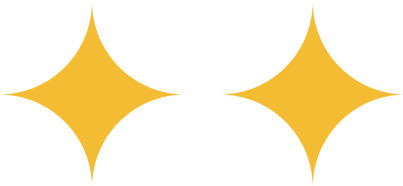

Climate is the average measurements of temperature, wind, humidity, snow, and rain in a place **over the course of years.**

Climate can determine a lot of things, but it especially determines what kind of plants and animals can live in an area.

For example, polar bears need a cold climate.

Weather vs Climate

Climate describes the typical weather conditions in an entire region for a **very long time—30 years or more.**

Climates can change over long periods of time.

Types of Climate....

Tropical - hot and humid zone

Dry - These climate zones are so dry because moisture is rapidly evaporated from the air

Temperate - warm and humid summers with thunderstorms and mild winters.

Continental - warm to cool summers and very cold winters.

Polar - extremely cold.
