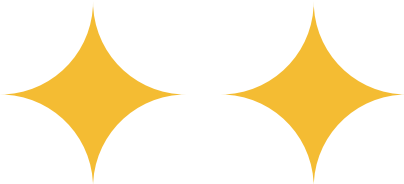
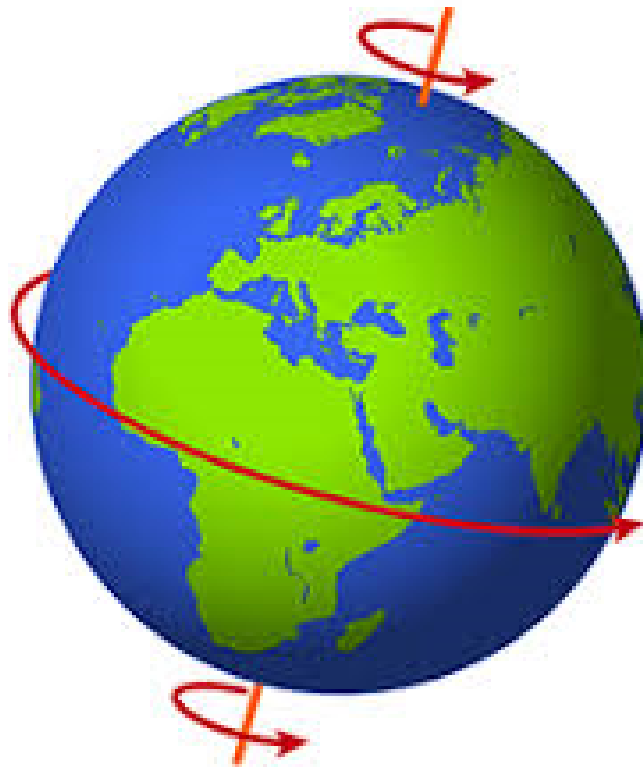

it's the **only one that has life on it...** Life of all types, plants and animals...

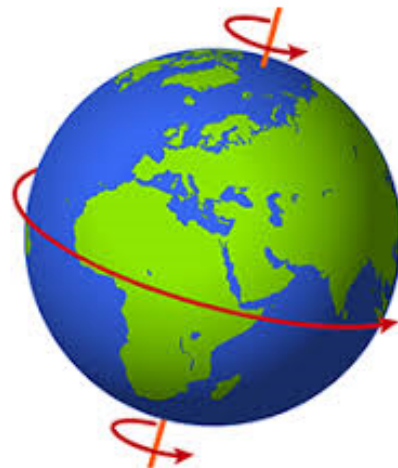


Earth moves in two ways...

Have you ever wondered, Where does the sun go when we can't see it?

It's still there! We're the ones who moved...!!

Like other planets of the solar system, the Earth moves in two different ways: one is called rotation... and the other is called revolution.



Let's Remember

There is rotation, which is the Earth turning around itself... causing day and night...which lasts exactly 24 hours, the same as a whole day.

And there is revolution, which is the earth travelling around the sun... which takes 365 days and causes the seasons.

So, now you

know the movements of the Earth.

Interesting Facts

- **AT ANY MOMENT, HALF OF THE WORLD IS IN DAYTIME AND HALF IS IN NIGHTTIME.**
- **IN SUMMER THE DAYS ARE LONGER THAN THEY ARE IN WINTER. IN LONDON, THE LONGEST DAY IS ABOUT 16 HOURS AND 39 MINUTES AND THE SHORTEST IS 7 HOURS AND 45 MINUTES.**
- **THE EARTH IS NOT A PERFECT SPHERE**
- **A DAY ON EARTH ISN'T ACTUALLY 24 HOURS - WE ALL KNOW A DAY ON EARTH IS 24 HOURS, BUT THIS IS SLIGHTLY WRONG. SINCE THE EARTH IS ROTATING AND ORBITING THE SUN, IT CREATES A SLIGHT DIFFERENCE IN TIME, MAKING THE LENGTH OF A DAY ACTUALLY BE 23 HOURS AND 56 MINUTES LONG.**
- **THE EARTH RECEIVES ONE MILLION BILLION CUBIC FEET OF SNOW EACH YEAR**
