Parts of a Sentence



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Introduction

In everyday life, people use sentences both in speech and in writing.

Once you know the parts of a sentence, and how to identify them, you can write and form logical sentences that will be well understood by others.

That will improve your writing skills !

To make a sentence, we need two basic parts: a subject and a verb.

Example

Subject.

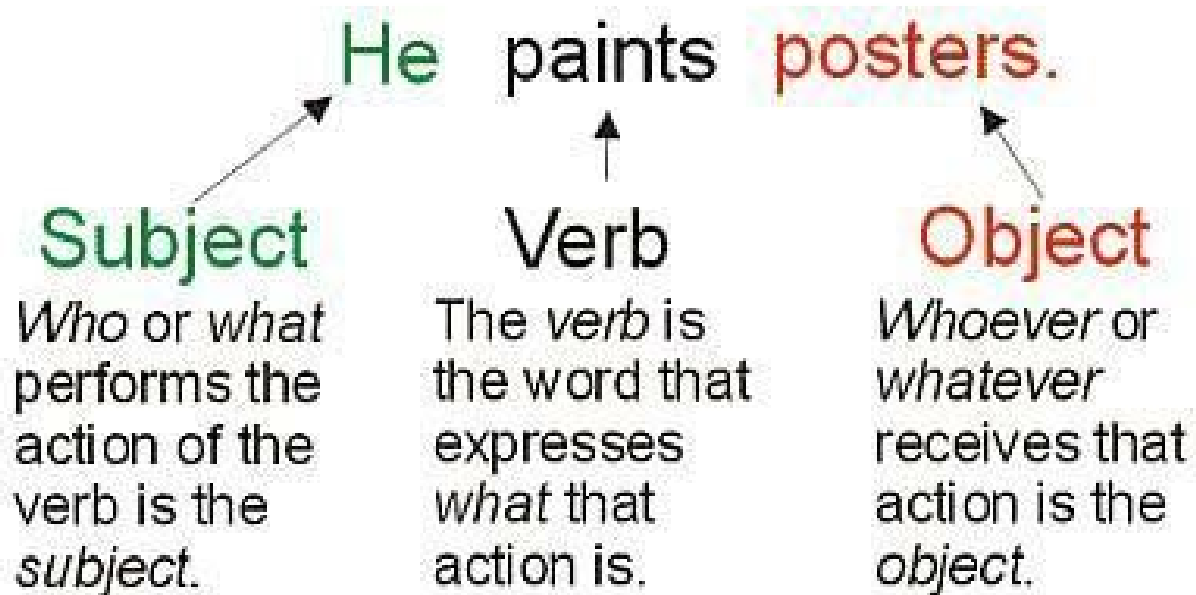
The subject of a sentence is the person, place, or thing that the sentence is about.

Predicate.

The predicate always includes and starts with a verb. Or we can say that ("Predicate" is also a verb that means, "to state something.

Direct and Indirect Objects.

Objects are noun phrases that are included in the predicate. They are the things being acted upon by the verb.
